There could be many reasons why people shift careers. Nagbabago sila ng trabaho dahil gusto nilang unahin ang kapakanan ng kanilang pamilya, o di kaya'y tinatawag sila ng Diyos sa ibang klaseng paglilingkod. Ang iba naman ay naghahanap ng greater job satisfaction, challenges, or independence. Whatever your reason or reasons for changing the direction and focus of your career, it's best that you prepare for it. Here are some questions for you to think about if you're planning your next career move:

What are your strong qualities? What are your weak ones? You need to be aware hindi lang kung saan ka magaling, kundi saan ka rin mahina para magawan mo pa ng paraan.

In relation to this, ask also yourself: **What key skills and abilities are required in your new field of interest?** Anu-ano ang mga kakayahang kailangan sa bagong trabahong nais mong pasukin? Meron ka ba nito? Kung wala, ano ang puwede mong gawin para magkaroon ka ng ganitong skill o competency? For example, if you want to shift to a teaching vocation, pero hindi ka naman tapos ng Education, you need to get at least a minimum of 18 professional units para ka makapagturo. Today, there are many kinds of short term courses available that can help you gain some background on the field you want to enter.

Another important question is this: **Is it more beneficial for you to change career right now?** Mas makakabuti ba kung mag-iiba ka ng linya ng trabaho ngayon o mas mabuting manatili ka sa kasalukuyan mong ginagawa? Count not only the benefits, but count also the cost. Are you ready to pay the price that goes with changing careers? Kung natitiyak mong mas mabuti ngang ibahin mo na ang takbo ng iyong career, then stick to your decision. Enjoy your new career and ask God to give you the grace to persevere through trials and challenges sa iyong bagong trabaho. According to Brian Koslow, “The freedom to move forward to new opportunities and to produce results comes from living in the present not the past.” Kung gusto mong sumulong at umunlad sa larangan ng iyong propesyong pinili, kailangang mamuhay ka sa kasalukuyan at hindi sa nakaraan. Pero sinabi rin ni Jose Rizal, “Ang hindi lumingon sa pinanggalingan ay hindi makararating sa paroroonan.” Before you move forward to new job opportunities, don’t forget to do the following things:

**First, talk to your family, friends, and mentors about your career plans.** Ayon sa Proverbs 15:22, “Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed.” Maaaring makapagbigay sa iyo ng mga insights at leads ang mga mahal mo sa buhay. Most of all, they can pray for you and help you discern God’s will as you make your career move.

**Second, revise and send out your resume.** Update your resume especially the sections on education, work experience, skills, and other qualifications. Place your resume on job sites sa internet. Send resumes sa mga kumpanyang naghahanap ng posisyong target mo. Makinig sa mga radio stations tulad ng DZAS na merong mga job vacancy announcements. Contact your friends and acquaintances in the industry who might know some companies na nangangailangan ng posisyong nais mo.

In the meantime, **complete your assigned work and hand-over your duties to your successor.** Tapusin mo nang maayos ang lahat ng mga responsibilidad mo sa iyong kasalukuyang pinagtrabahuhan kung hindi pa in effect ang iyong resignation. Mas mainam na sa pag-alis mo sa iyong kasalukuyang trabaho, walang pangit na masasabi sa iyo ang iyong boss at ang iyong mga katrabaho. Instead, may maiiwan ka pang magandang testimony dahil naging masipag at responsible ka sa iyong trabaho.

Kung sakali namang na-dismiss ka sa trabaho, **ask management about the nature of your dismissal so that you can be aware of your faults and shortcomings.** Aminin mo kung nagkulang ka nga at nagkamali at sikapin mong iwasan ang ganitong pangyayari sa bago mong lilipatang trabaho.

Bago ka umalis, **check also with your superior or with the accounting office matters regarding your termination benefits.**

Finally, **be thankful to God for all the blessings and learning experiences you had while on your previous job.** Kalimutan mo na rin ang mga naranasan mong hindi magaganda at patawarin mo ang mga kasamahan sa trabahong nakasakit sa iyo. Have a clean slate by forgiving others. Only then can you truly move forward and receive the blessings of God on your new career.
